We are committed not only to helping address current issues but to making a lasting contribution toward a more resilient and sustainable future for our industry.

PVH is committed to Bangladesh as a sourcing country. The Accord has made a demonstrative positive impact upon fire, structural, electrical and occupational safety in Bangladesh's readymade garment industry. All stakeholders, with the support of the International Labour Organisation, must negotiate an agreement that builds on this progress. The establishment of the Readymade Garment Sustainability

Council as the implementing body for the Accord brings national stakeholders to the forefront of these efforts. International brand owners have an ongoing role to play in ensuring the advances made become fully embedded for the long-term, while recognizing that in order for factory safety to be sustainable, we need national governments, local industry and civil society, including worker representatives at a country level, to be part of the solution.
